Students are also trained to provide important support services in elementary public schools as teacher assistants. Career Opportunities: Director, Assistant Director, Supervisor, Coordinator, Childcare Teacher, Childcare Advocate in various early childhood, organizations, or social programs.

DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

Associate in Applied Science (AAS) Degree – CAREER

This is a 2-year ECE program designed to prepare students to go directly to work upon completion, typically as center directors, child care teachers, and assistant teachers in Head Start and public schools.

Associate in Science (AS) Degree -TRANSFER

This is a 2-year ECE program designed to prepare students to transfer to a University to complete a bachelor's degree in ECE. Courses include general education requirements specific for education majors that work toward the B.S. degree.
