To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your submitted FAFSA application with the information we have requested below from you to determine if a correction needs to be done to your FAFSA application. You will need to attach any required documents below and submit the information to us. We may ask for additional information. Your file cannot be completed until we verify any information questioned on this form. You will be responsible for any charges to your account until your financial aid file is complete and an award is posted to your student portal.
