



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
Gallaudet University  
AND  
John A. Logan College (JALC)

**BA in Interpretation Students**

This document establishes an articulation agreement between Gallaudet University, located at 800 Florida Ave NE, Washington, DC 20002, and John A. Logan College, located at 700 Logan College Road, Carterville, Illinois 62918. The intention of this agreement is to facilitate the transfer process of academic credits of qualified students from the regionally accredited John A. Logan College to the four-year program at regionally accredited Gallaudet University for the express purpose of providing an American Sign Language interpretation program at the baccalaureate level. By entering into this contract, Gallaudet University agrees to provide JALC with comprehensive historical enrollment and graduation data for all former JALC students attending Gallaudet University once every year, no later than July 1 of each year.

Students completing the Associate in Applied Science degree in Interpreter Education at John A. Logan College, in accordance with the minimum standards set by Gallaudet University, may be admitted to the Bachelors of Arts in Interpretation provided they meet eligibility standards established by Gallaudet University Office of Admissions and Department of Interpretation. Students who do not meet the aforementioned minimum standards will be considered for admission to Gallaudet University on a case-by-case basis. The guidelines that govern this articulation agreement are described below.


- Hearing prospective students must be accepted into the BAI program. Deaf and hard of hearing prospective students must be accepted first into the undergraduate program in order to apply for the Bachelors of Arts in Interpretation program.
- The Department of Interpretation at Gallaudet University will refer to the accompanying schedule of specific transfer matriculation courses from John A. Logan College for transferees into its Interpreting Program, such schedule being stipulated as an integral part of this document upon signing.
- Gallaudet University guarantees the transfer of college-level credits, provided that all coursework have been completed with a grade of "C" or the equivalent.

- Placement testing is required of all new, transfer, and special students who have been accepted to Gallaudet University. All new, transfer, and special students are required to complete an American Sign Language (ASL) Placement Test for GSR 103 course. Students with three hours credit in college English with grades of "C" or higher will not take the English placement test. Students with three hours credit in college math with grades of "C" or higher will not take the Math placement test.
- Students are required to maintain grades of "B" or higher in all Interpreting courses taken at John A. Logan College that are required for the Bachelor of Arts in Interpretation major at Gallaudet University.
- Students must pass ASLPI (ASL Proficiency Interview) with a score of 3 to be accepted into program. If the student receive a score of 2+ or 2, the student will be accepted into the program with a conditional status.
- Students will not be required to submit ACT score report. It has been waived with more than 30 transferred credits.
- Admitted hearing undergraduate students are eligible for financial aid through federal programs, but are not eligible for merit-based financial aid awarded to deaf and hard of hearing students.
- The Gallaudet University Office of Admissions reserves the right to request additional documentation and standardized testing from any potential transferee.
- Implementation and interpretation of this Articulation Agreement will be consistent with applicable and mandatory policies and procedures established by the accrediting and governing bodies of this institution and other agencies having jurisdiction over either institution.

This agreement becomes effective with the signatures of all parties and shall continue in effect unless voided by either party upon sixty (60) days prior written notice. Gallaudet University and John A. Logan College will consider in good faith any amendments either party proposes. Gallaudet University and John A. Logan College will hold each other harmless for all decisions entered into under this agreement. The agreement may only be amended in writing, with amendments signed by both parties.


If at any time, this agreement conflicts with the policies and procedures of either institution, the agreement becomes null and void immediately upon written notification.
