Students admitted to the Bachelors in Interdisciplinary Studies (IDS) program will need to meet the following requirements for completion of their degree.

Junior/Senior Level Courses	40 credit hours
EIU-Specific Courses	20 credit hours
Math & Science Electives	12 credit hours
Social & Behavioral Electives	12 credit hours
Humanities & Fine Arts Electives	12 credit hours
Communication & Language	6 credit hours
Senior Seminar	1 course
Cultural Diversity	1 course
IDS-Specific Courses (at EIU)	3 courses

Students may transfer up to 78 semester credit hours from a community college. For those who have completed a Baccalaureate-oriented Associates degree and have met the IAI GECC requirements will be judged as having met all lower-level general education requirements for the IDS degree.
