We have categorized the following sections to help you understand which courses are most valuable to your college career. General Education Courses (often called "generals") are courses in a wide range of subject areas that must be completed to fulfill your core curriculum before you begin taking courses needed for your chosen college major. General Education courses fit into the following categories: Communications; Fine Arts & Humanities; Social & Behavioral Sciences; Mathematics; Life & Physical Sciences. Additionally, you need a few Electives to earn the minimum number of credit hours required to graduate. Electives allow you to do some career exploration, take classes needed for transfer to another institution, or just learn more about subjects that interest you.
